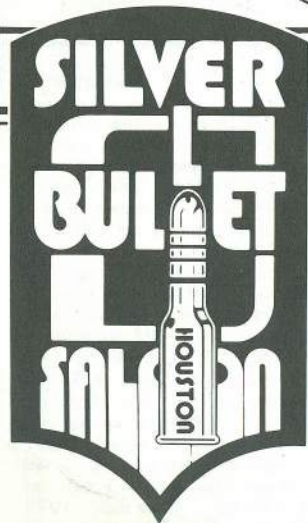

## PLAYBOY GRANT FOR NGTF

The National Gay Task Force has received a \$7500 matching grant from the Playboy Foundation for research, preparation of materials, and other expenses in connection with the meetings with federal agencies occurring over the next few months.
