Correction time: The new Woody Allen movie has been titled *Annie Hall*, not *Annie Hill* as I had previously reported. The film is to star Allen, ex-wife Diane Keaton, Paul Simon, Tony Roberts, Colleen Dewhurst, and Shelley Duvall; it should be released this summer.

Last week's Television Critics Circle Awards, tacky though they may have been, are in effect this year's Emmy awards. This year's Emmy award show has been canceled. The reason is that the various chapters of the Television Academy are still feuding. The Hollywood Chapter has withdrawn from the Academy because of complaints it has against the New York Chapter. So, those who won the Critics Circle Awards have in effect won the only important television awards for this year.

The televised broadcast of this year's Oscars was the lowest-rated Academy Awards Show ever on TV. Producer Billy Friedkin apparently erred by taking away the usual pomp and glitter associated with the Award Show and replacing it with the "New Hollywood" faces and routines. The public (rightly or wrongly) wasn't buying, ABC lost its apparent edge in the ratings for that time block, and plans are already underway to replace the missing elements for next year's show. It'll be Oscar's 50th birthday.

This year's Oscar winners are busily making the best of their victories. Best actress Faye Dunaway wisely waited until after the ceremony before accepting her next film commitment. By doing so, she doubled her asking price, which was met by Jon Peters, who will produce her next

film. Best director John Avildsun (for *Rocky*) will direct Sylvester Stallone in *Rocky Returns*. Stallone himself, who lost out Best Actor honors to the late Peter Finch, is crying all the way to the box office. *Rocky* is breaking records everywhere, and he's already signed for two movies, entitled *F.I.S.T.* and *Hell's Kitchen*. Best Song winner Barbra Streisand is given such high marks for her efforts in putting *A Star Is Born* together that she's being seriously considered as a director on several future projects.

New movies that are currently in production: *Rollercoaster*, a film featuring Sensurround as well as Timothy Bottoms, Henry Fonda, and Richard Widmark; *The World's Greatest Lover*, directed by and starring Gene Wilder; *Going Home*, a film about Viet vets with Jon Voight, Jane Fonda, and

Bruce Dern; *Heroes*, with Henry Winkler, Talia Shire, and Sally Field; and Mae West's *Sextette*.

Broadway Kernels: Carol Channing will be appearing in the Houston Grand Opera's production of *Hello Dolly*. They'll tour the country, as well as play an extended run on Broadway; A multi-media presentation of the lives and times of the Beatles is being prepared for Broadway, entitled, appropriately *Beatlemania*; Liza Minnelli will appear in a musical revue written especially for her by *Cabaret* songwriters Kander and Ebb, titled *In Person*. Liza's current tour is not doing well, and her latest film, New York, New York, is still unreleased.

What's Popping?: The saga of the *Tonight Show* goes on. Rumor has it that a replacement for Carson is being sought, either because of low ratings or his desire to exit the show after 14 years.
