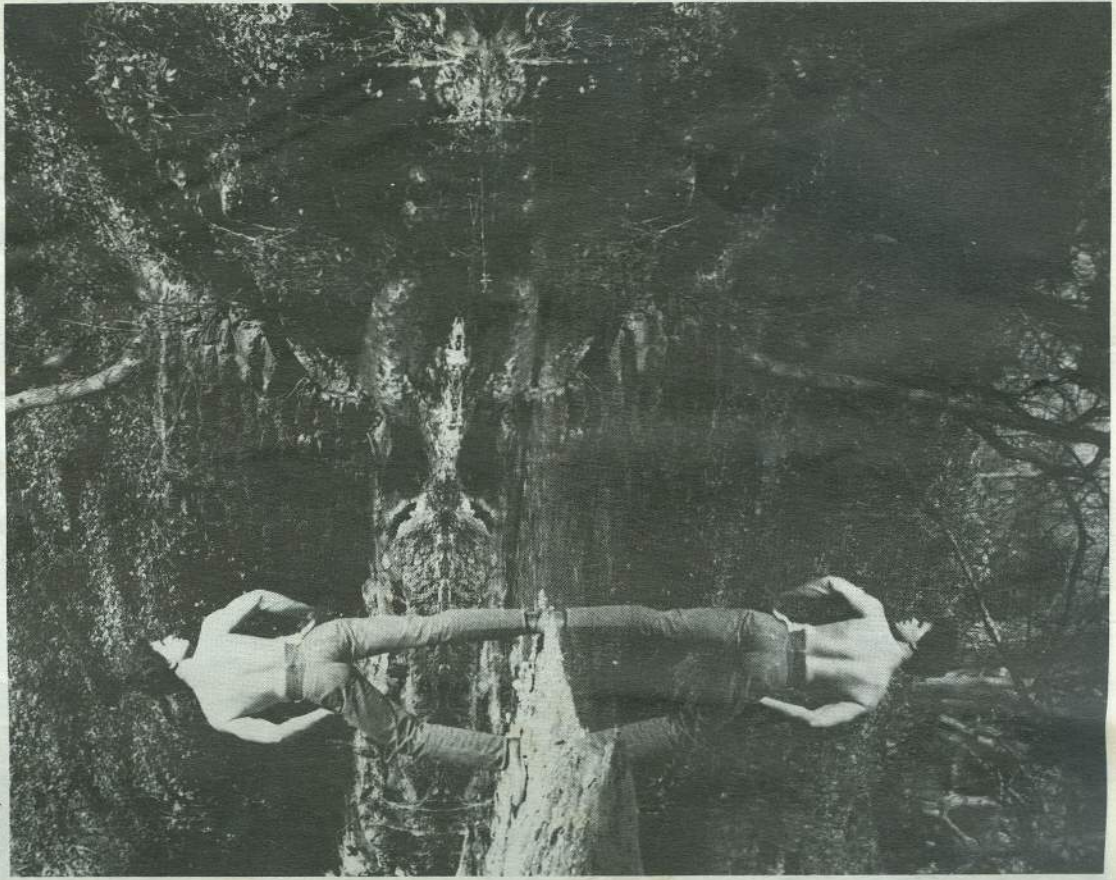

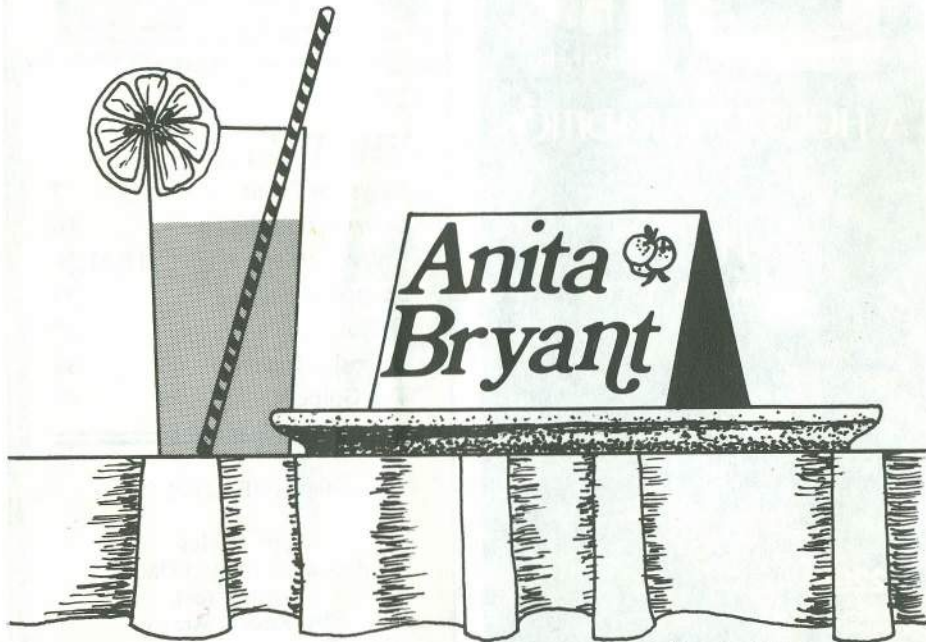

There is a strong anti-gay movement beginning to surface in this country. Currently, Ms. Anita Bryant is considered by some to be the most noted and celebrated homophobe in our nation. And she is coming to Houston in one more week--or at least the best information available as of this writing indicates this to be so.

I have offered \$1,000 to Anita Bryant--her usual appearance fee--to debate the issue in open forum on Saturday evening, June 18, with gay rights advocates. This article is not intended to guarantee success in picking up a trick or meeting a potential new lover, so if you intend to rush right out and find Mr. Right after finishing this essay, then we are making something very complicated appear all too simple.

But, there are some very definite do's and don'ts in the "art of cruising." Let's examine the most common and most effective techniques.

and away from the dance floor. Those standing at the edge of the dance floor are usually too busy watching the light show and dancers to notice anyone else. So, move back into a side bar or against a wall where there aren't a lot of people. If you're standing in a crowd, no one can notice you. 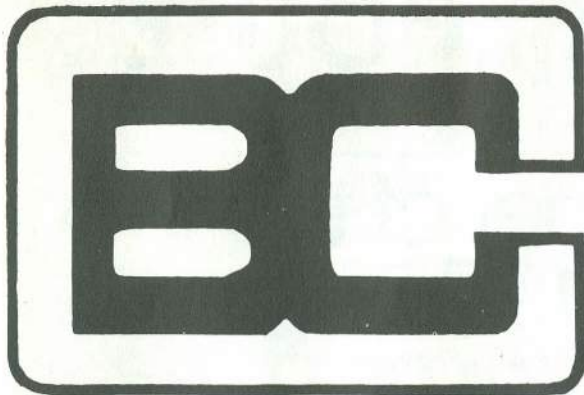

stay alone and stand alone. Sitting on a barstool is not a place to be noticed since the crowd will only see your back and will most likely pass you by.
