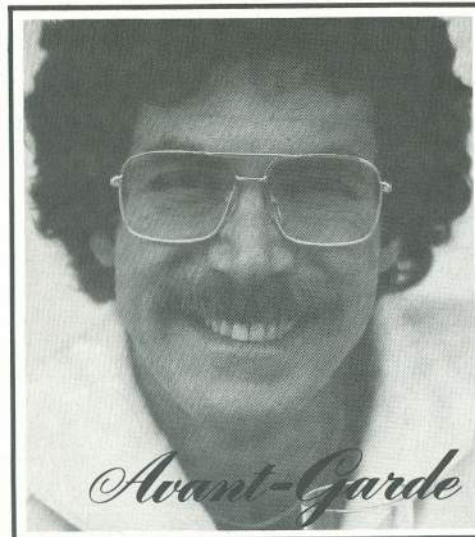
"Stop! Stop right there," Vera ordered, slamming the lid closed on Phoebe's suitcase. And Phoebe's fingers.


## HOUSTON BAR OWNER KILLED

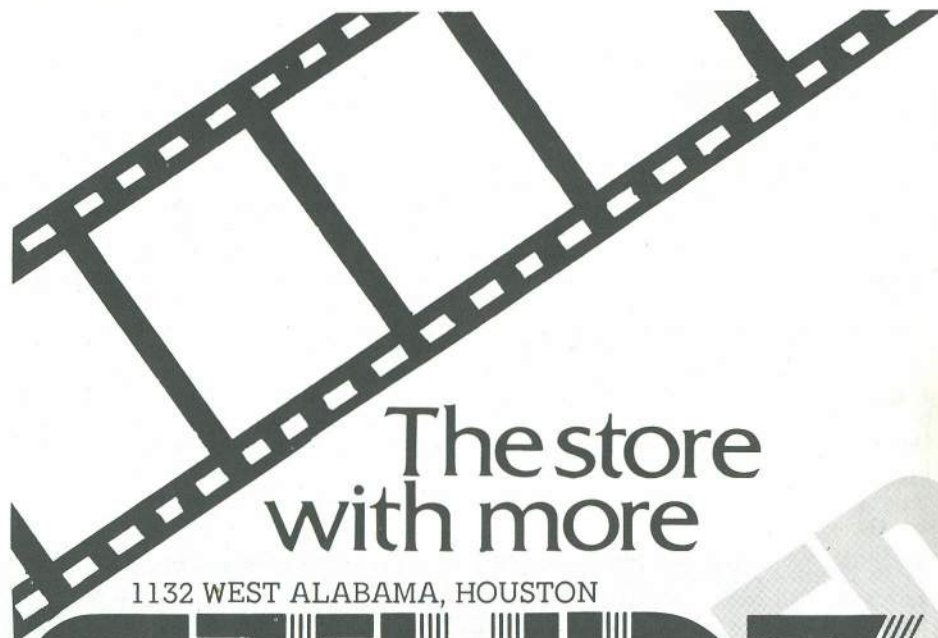

## review

*RAZZMATAZZ...and all that Jazz!*, now playing at Houston's Theatre Suburbia, is low-budget, small-stage, coarse, undignified, spotty, non-pretentious — and LOTS of fun. Lots of fun!

Don't let the name of the theatre or its location deceive you. Those folks out there are currently providing a much-needed commodity on the Houston theatrical scene. Namely, experimentation. Not the kind of experimentation that conjures visions of multi-media, avant-garde, college-thesis presentations, but WORKING experimentation. Despite a limited budget and cramped quarters, Theatre Suburbia is offering WORKING opportunities for Houstonians with flair de' theatrical.


*Razzmatazz*, a spoof of the Mayer-Freed-Minnelli musical movie spectaculars of the 1939-to-1948 era, was home-written by Paul Hager and plays well, with touches of scripting sophistication that required curbing for the "meller-dramer" nature of the project. Future moves to more structured, legitimate writing efforts should come with ease. But Haner

already scores well on sheer entertainment points. *Razzmatazz* IS highly entertaining.

Contributing to the overall event is Theatre Suburbia's relaxed, laid-back atmosphere, which is due to the efforts of the resident director Jean Montgomery. Her directorial style lacks strong discipline, but that comes across in the Theatre Suburbia environment as more of a plus than a minus. Besides, she personally belts a few tunes before showtime and during intermission. And from that point on, mark the audiences as feeling nothing less than sheer love and adoration for Ms. Montgomery.

The cast wallops energy, if not professional talent, at every turn. Villains are boo-ed, heroes cheered, and dancers applauded. And while there are no immediate future Tony winners in the lot, they know how to sell fun both for themselves and for the audience — Real Fun!

Finally, sets are weak for lack of funds. Lighting appears weak for lack of imagination. But criticism on these points is like criticizing a rollercoaster for lack of air-conditioning — the Hager-Montgomery works. And with footnote praise to musical director Toni Anderson, the show is recommended!
