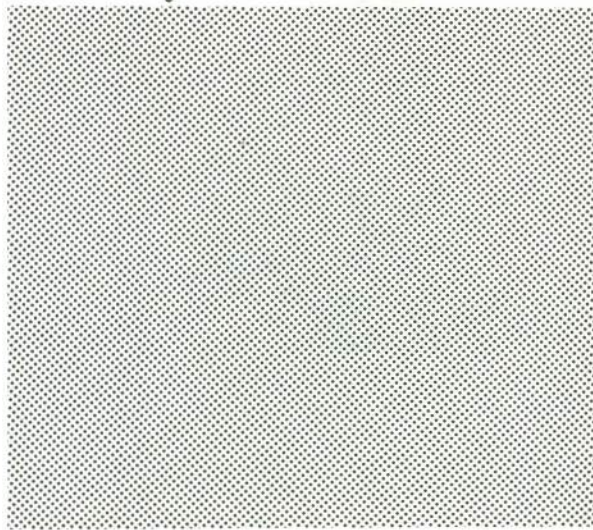
AN OPEN LETTER TO OUR CUSTOMERS
