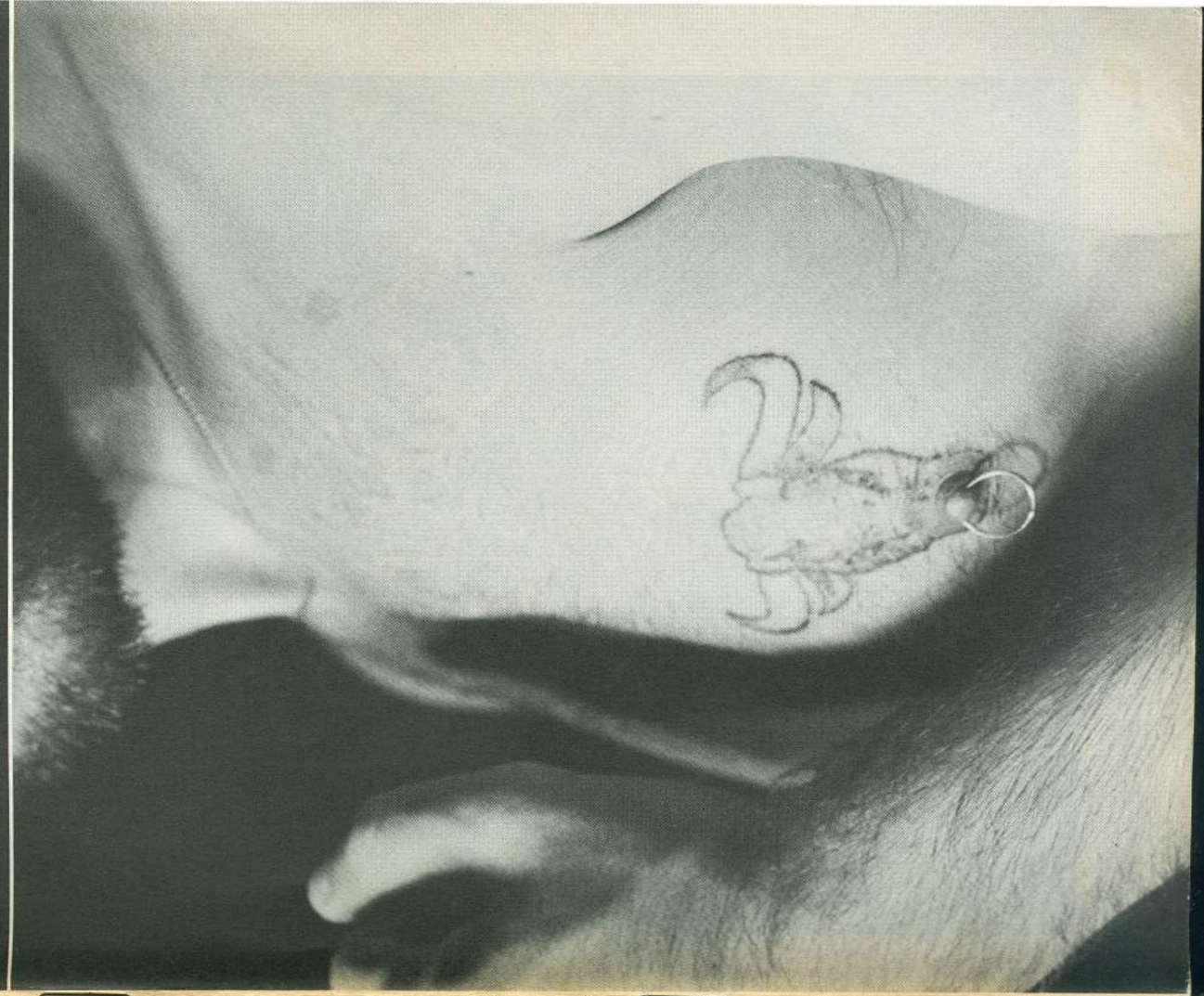
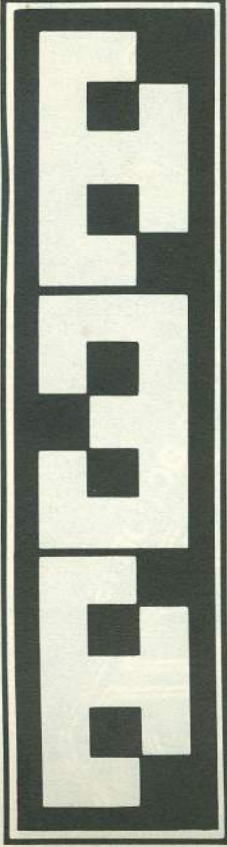

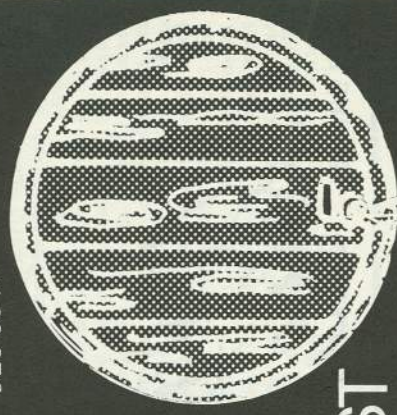

The following article by Bob Jones, former manager of Houston's Levi's Club, should be read by every reader of TWT and passed on to as many others as possible. The conspiracy of harrasment he discusses is a statewide one and this oppression will reach every citizen of Texas, even though it is most evident in Houston at the present time. TWT cannot make it emphatic enough that this struggle is of paramount importance to your survival and that your support is vital!

DEAR RESIDENTS AND VISITORS TO THE MONTROSE AREA:

On June 22, 1977, myself and Neil Mann were brutally attacked and beaten by members of the HPD Vice Squad. We were then jailed and held without bond or any charges being pressed against us for 13 hours, before the trumped up charge of "Interferring with a Police Officer" was placed against us.

A customer of the Levi's Lounge who none of us even knew before this incident also was taken into custody, detained without bond or charges placed against him for the same period of 13 hours, and then charged with the same offense, and his only misbehavior was simply being in the bar and asking one of the un-uniformed unidentified plainclothesmen to identify himself.

Since that date, my life has been threatened no less than three times. The first threat was by one of the HPD plainclothes vice officers who showed up at the front

door of my home with a switchblade knife the morning after our eventual release.

Levi's was subjected to frequent and unprovoked surveillance by the HPD and raided again. The second time they arrested John Tillotson, who is a bartender at Levi's, and several customers. The HPD promised to return again and again until they ran us out of business. (They used the same tactics on the Exile Club, which was also forced out of business.)

One vice officer vowed to close every business catering to members of the Montrose Community. A total of 12 people were illegally taken into custody, arrested and detained during the so-called "raids" by plainclothes HPD members who never gave any identification to these people at the time during the incidents at Levi's. All were subjected to vile and degrading verbal abuse by members of the HPD, and some were targets of extreme physical violence by members of the HPD while they were in custody.

It is time for the citizens, residents of, and visitors to the Montrose Community to unite and to forget our personal differences and personal prejudices against one another. Our lifestyles are at stake! Our jobs are in jeopardy! Some of us even fear for our lives!

Yet, we are a divided community, even in the aftermath of all that already has happened not only in the above, but including *hundreds* of other unrelated similar arrests and stories known to many people privately, but still not a matter of



public record, which have occurred in the last few months in Montrose.

We will not survive if we continue to let our petty personal disagreements and prejudices between one another take precedence over our common and individual stake against this war of hate that has been declared and already initiated.

We now have an opportunity to fight back. We still have survivors who can, and will, testify in Federal Court and prove that our human rights are being threatened and denied. We have a cause for unity. I beg you — Please help us.

This is not a fight for Bob Jones or Levi's, or Jim Farmer, or anyone else personally. It is a fight for every human being in the Montrose Community.

A civil rights suit was filed in Federal Court in Houston at 4:30pm, Tuesday, August 9. It was filed on faith alone on our behalf and on behalf of all of us, including all those people who thus far have not been personally arrested and brutalized by "accident," simply by virtue of being a customer of, visitor to, employee or owner of, some Montrose business.

The attorneys in that suit, both of record and those who have contributed but are not of record, have been working without pay on the matter and entirely on volunteer time.

This suit and all the related matters, including weeks of good-faith cooperation with HPD Internal Affairs, the FBI, and court appearances on behalf of people

I will guarantee personally that should we win the case in Federal Court, and we will, that all money contributed by the community will be returned to a trust fund that will be used for so long as is necessary

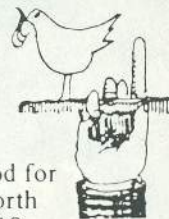

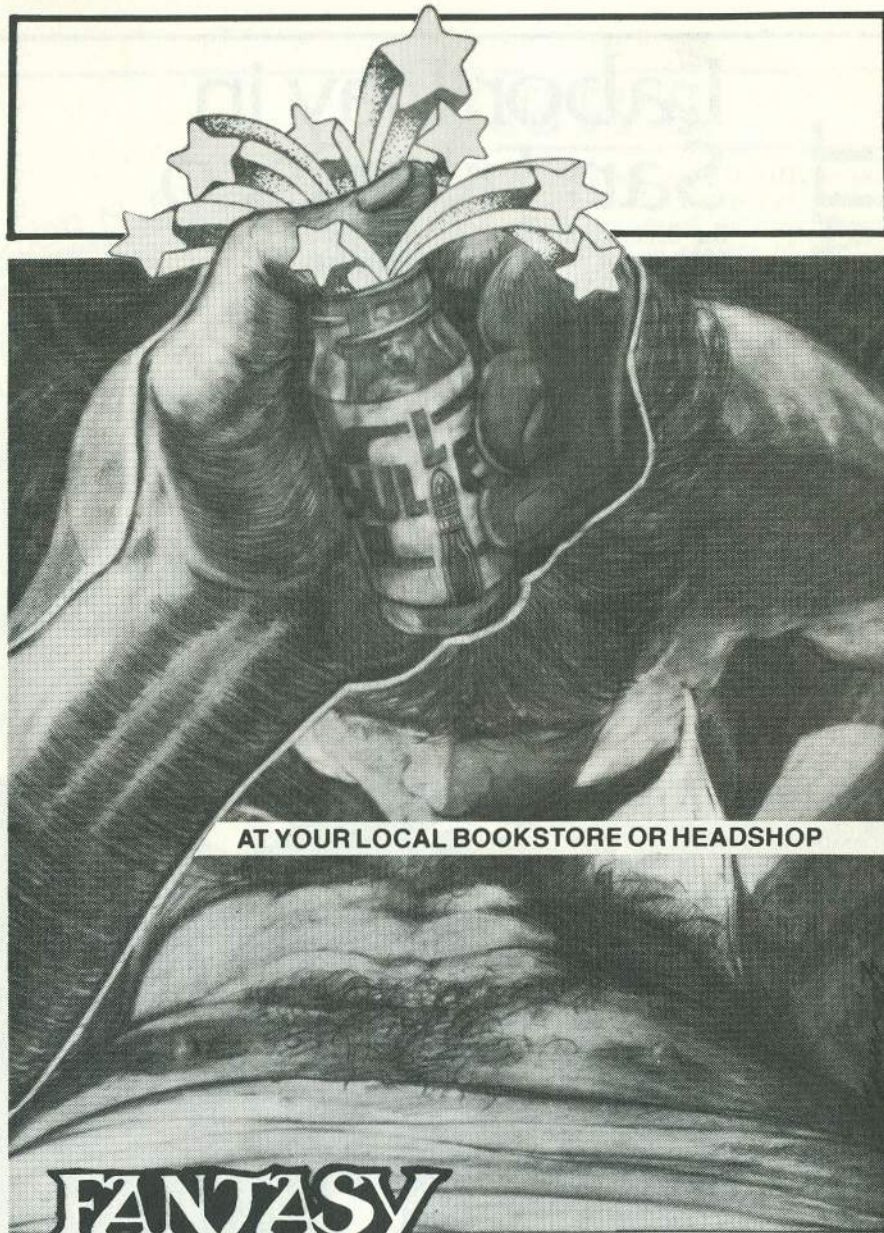

THE QUEENS OF ENGLAND by Professor Paul

On this Jubilee year of Queen Elizabeth II, it may be interesting to note that England has had more queens as rulers than the chronicles would lead us to believe, as cases in point — Kings William II, Richard I, Richard II, Edward II, and James I (maybe the "second" has something to do with it?).

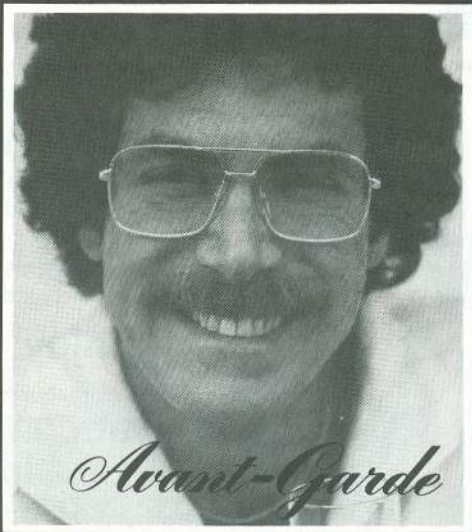
Richard II, who had the intelligence
