### STAND UP NOW

Due to repeated incidents of harassment of law-abiding citizens of Houston, including specific incidents of harassment aimed at the gay citizens and gay-oriented businesses of this city by the Houston Police Department and its officers, a group of concerned citizens has come together to form the STAND UP NOW COMMITTEE of the Houston Human Rights Defense Fund, a non-profit organization. Stand Up Now (SUN) is engaged in coordinating activities and fund-raising aimed at reducing oppression of all minorities by the officers of the HPD.

SUN has chosen the closing of the Levi Lounge as its first fund-raising cause. A lawsuit has been instituted against the officers involved in this extreme violation of Human Rights guaranteed by the United Nations Charter, as well as the more recent Helsinki Agreement. Due to these oppressive acts, Levi's closed voluntarily rather than subjecting its customers to the kind of dangers that remaining open would have engendered.

If you have any information about this or any other incidents of uncalled-for a-

buse by the HPD, report it to SUN either by phone, (713-528-7648), or in person at the SUN headquarters, 3400 Montrose, Suite 401, Houston. If you are able to offer any aid, either physical or financial, please contact SUN. Houstonians have reached the point at which their human rights are at stake. The time has come to STAND UP NOW.

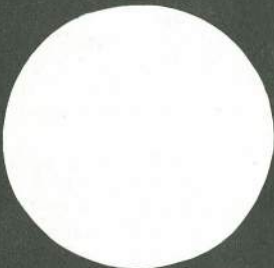



## popcorn

The networks call it "stunting." To you and me, though, it's called "event programming." It's the new trend in network programming for the upcoming season and for the foreseeable future. What it means is more special events are programmed into the schedule and less programming for regular series. *Roots* started it all for ABC, and last season NBC made it a regular occurrence with its *Big Event*. Now it's the prime focus for all three networks. Each network is trying to come out with more, bigger, and better events. In fact, many of them will be aired as you are reading this.

It's going to be the most exciting television season in many years. The ratings race was turned upside down last year, which means it's anybody's game this year. ABC, now on top for the first time ever, will be doing most anything to stay there, but they will be basically relying on those shows that put them where they were last season. CBS and NBC will be busy trying to depose ABC, using

every trick in the book. What all that means is that there will be programming that is more likely to be of good quality.

As each network gets ready, they are shuffling and reshuffling their schedules, attempting to get the best possible start. It would be superfluous, therefore, to attempt to discuss the fall schedule as it now stands, because it is unlikely the schedule would be the same two days from now. Instead, let's look at some trends you can expect this season:

(1) *More event programming.* The "events" will be anything from boxing matches to Miss America Pageants.

(2) *Longer premiere week(s).* New shows will be debuting from now til October instead of all in one week as usual.

(3) *No more seasons beginning in September and January with reruns in the summer.* Instead, there will be a constantly evolving lineup of shows.

(4) *Faster cancellations of series.* In fact, between the three networks,
