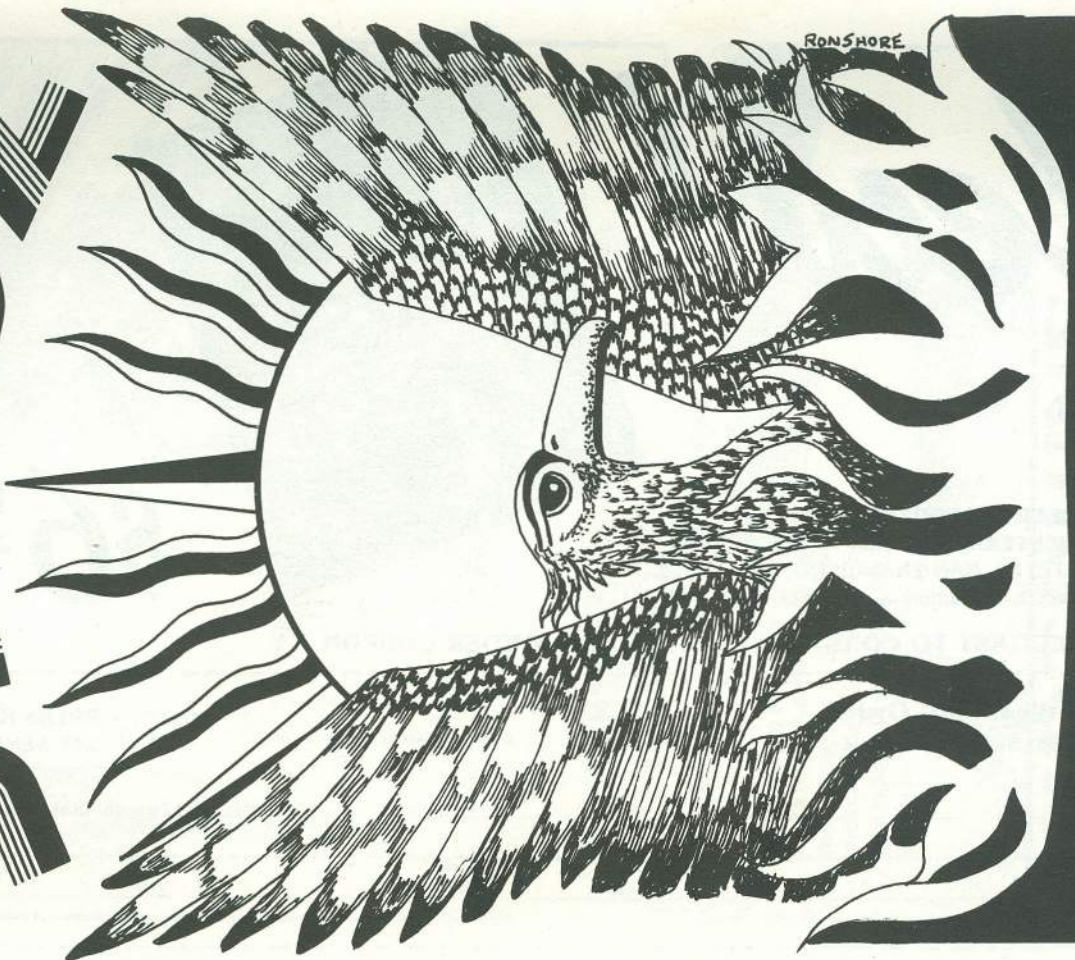

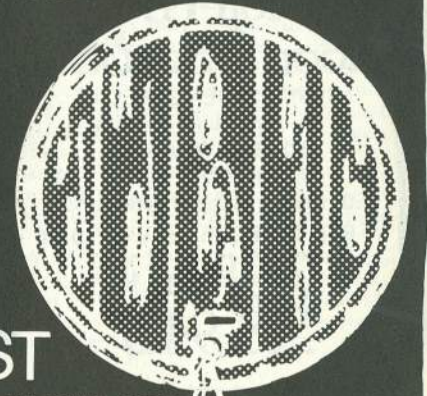

# news up front

## HILL BEATS CITY CHARGES

Ray Hill won his battle against the City of Houston and its Vice Squad when the judge Tuesday dropped all charges against Hill.

Charges of interfering with a police officer were filed against Hill on June 24 when he turned on the lights in the back room of Studz News bookstore when three vice squad officers came into the store.

Municipal Court Judge Robert P. Youngman ruled in Hill's favor on a pre-trial motion to dismiss the charges because the charges failed to allege a culpable state on the part of the defendant.

Hill said that the judge's ruling meant that the charges must state that the charged party, "did knowingly, willfully, maliciously, or recklessly and unlawfully" do whatever it was that they were arrested for.

Failure to allege in those words makes the charge void due to fatal error, Hill

said.

There is already a pending federal suit on Hill's arrest, Montrose Ventures vs. Skipper, et al. Hill plans to file a personal suit against the arresting officers after the city decides whether it will refile the charges against him.

The class concept will be to "teach the individual how to use the equipment provided in the Midtowne and other similar facilities."

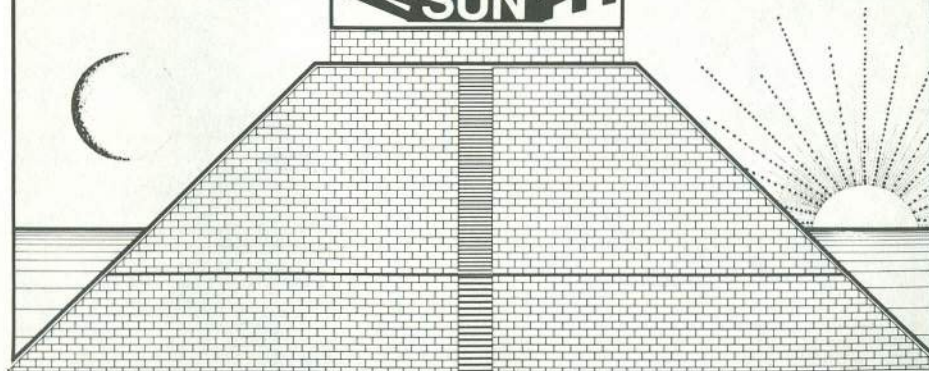
