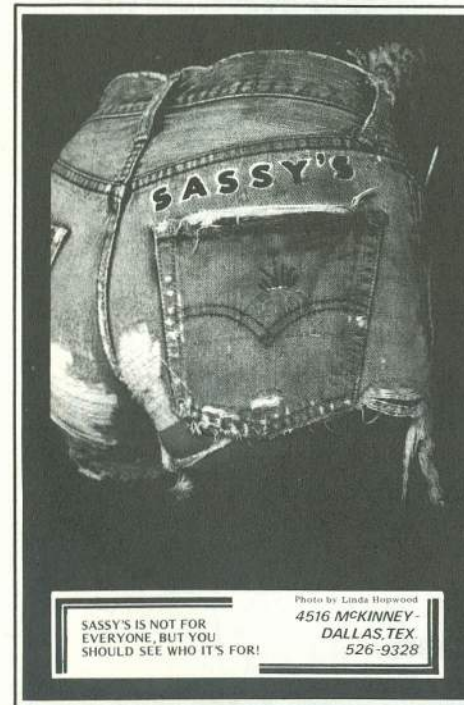

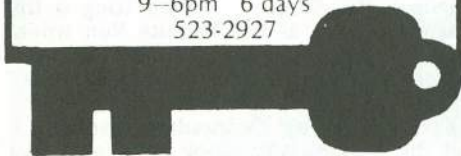

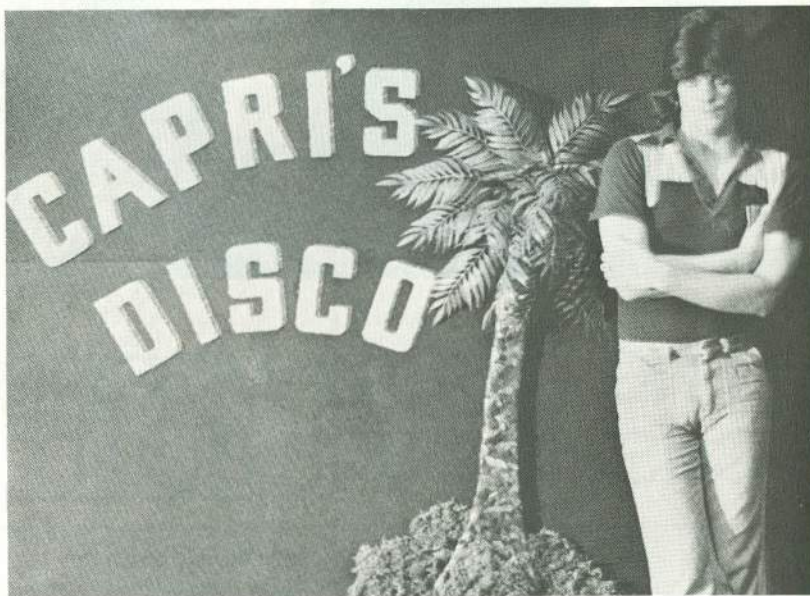

AUSTIN NEVER BOYCOTTED COORS

Austin Gay Bar Owners have under increasing pressure from segments of the Gay Community to demonstrate Bar support for Gay Rights by joining a boycott of COORS beer. Those present included representatives from SAFE, GCS, AFL-CIO, COORS (national and local), The Apartment Austin Country, Hollywood, Pearl Street Warehouse, and The Private Cellar. The COORS representative unequivocally endorsed his company's support of basic human rights and further stated that there is no known instance when the company has ever discriminated against an employee because of sexual orientation. Customers at several Houston adult bookstores have been harassed on an almost daily basis. One bookstore was even raided three times in one night by your vice squad. Literally hundreds of men and women in the Montrose area have been arrested in the past several months in an apparent campaign of police harassment that seems to have been coordinated by Frank Briscoe types and sympathizers in your Houston Police Department.

Various members of the Houston gay community have spoken out against Frank Briscoe and have urged gays in Houston to not vote for Frank Briscoe in the November 8 elections.

Mort Schwab, local attorney and former chairperson of Houston's Gay Political Caucus, says, "Briscoe's past, when he was district attorney, showed a blatant disregard for the law and his downfall came from a case that involved a gay defendant in which Briscoe is alleged to have falsified evidence, which led to a grand jury investigation and his indictment for falsification of evidence and his subsequent

resignation as district attorney."

Another GPC source, who preferred to remain anonymous, said, "Frank Briscoe was indicted about nine years ago for withholding evidence while he was district attorney. He is very much disliked by the local black and chicano communities because of his complete lack of support for the rights of minorities. He is probably implicated as the source of the recent rumours concerning Mayor Fred Hofheinz's personal reputation. Those widelycirculated rumours probably helped keep Hofheinz from running for a third term as mayor. These are three very good reasons for gays to vote against Briscoe."

Jim Higgins, an organizer of the Montrose Area Patrol, an informal patrol for the Montrose area, says, "Frank Briscoe's close ties with many police officials from the Herman Short era suggests that Mr. Briscoe would have to betray personal loyalties in any effort to curtail police excesses and corruption that make up the most serious problem facing our city and the new administration. I don't believe Mr. Briscoe can effectively clean up our police department."

Ray Hill, long-time Houston gay activist and executive director of the Houston



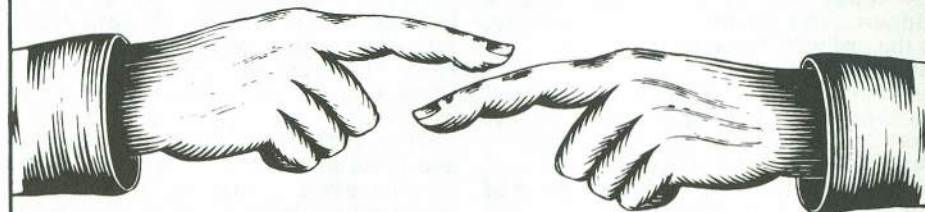

FRANK BRISCOE — MAYOR?

Of the more than ten candidates in this year's mayoral race, one stands out from the rest as the candidate that the Houston gay community should be sure NOT to support. This candidate, not surprisingly, is the one with the most vocal rhetoric on law and order.

That candidate is Frank Briscoe. Of all the candidates in the race — from socialist workers party to american nazi party — only one has specifically demonstrated his obvious lack of regard for the rights of minorities, and, at the same time, backed to the hilt, the police department in its current campaign of terror against the minorities of Houston.

Briscoe was an assistant district attorney of Harris County from 1950 to 1954 and again from 1957 to 1960. Then, in 1960 he was elected district attorney and held that position until he resigned in the face of an indictment from a grand jury that was investigating possible abuse of office by Mr. Briscoe. That grand jury indicted Briscoe for allegedly falsifying and/or withholding information in a

trial taking place at that time. Shortly thereafter he resigned as district attorney.

Since that time he has been a relatively low-key figure in Houston politics. In 1975 he ran against incumbent Mayor Fred Hofheinz and lost. This loss was attributed to the black and Mexican-American communities voting against him because of his extreme right-wing stand in support of the police department and its excesses.

Since 1975 police department excesses and harassment of the various minorities have increased in quantum jumps. These excesses have been, in recent months, directed mainly against the three most visible minorities of the Houston area: gays, blacks and chicanos.

Since May we have seen numerous instances of gays arrested and subjected to humiliating verbal and sometimes physical abuse. Many of these arrests have later been proven to be merely harassment-type arrests. Several local gay bars have been the targets of repeated high-intensity police harassment to the point where they had to close. One of these bars has even filed suit against the police in court.

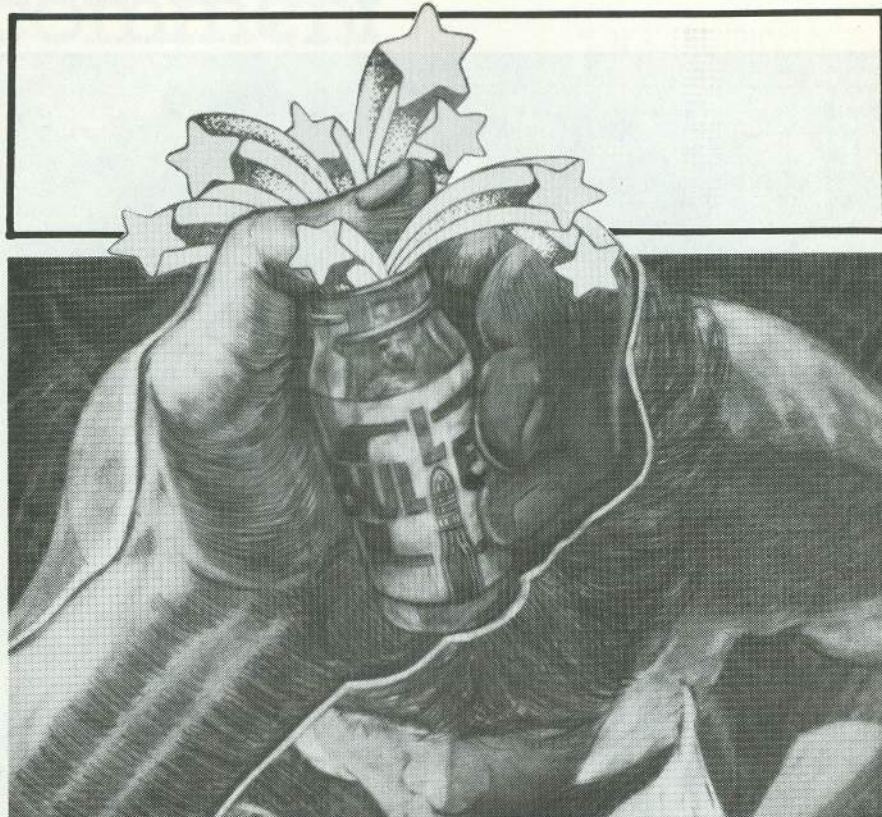

Human Rights League, had this to say about Frank Briscoe: "Frank Briscoe and his pro-police right-wing extremist stands would do nothing but reinforce present police policies which show excessive harassment of gays and the gay community as a whole. Traditionally Houston has enjoyed being one of the more comfortable places for gays to live and work in. But in recent months just the anticipation of the election of Frank Briscoe seems to have caused the harassment of gays and the Montrose-area gay community to increase many times more than we have ever experienced it in the past. If Frank Briscoe is elected mayor we can anticipate a return to the 1950's type of atmosphere, or worse, as he gives reinforcement to the kind of police-controlled society that won Joseph McCarthy fame and fortune."
