Among the onslaught of movie releases in the next few months will be a film called *Pretty Baby*, watch for it. It is the first American film by a well known French director named Louis Malle, and it tells a story set in a brothel in New Orleans' red-light district of the 1920's. Keith Carradine plays a photographer who falls in love with one of his models, a prostitute, played by twelve year old Brooke Shields. Malle, who calls *Pretty Baby*, a "weird love story," had no idea that this production, which was filmed entirely in New Orleans, would hit the screen at a time when the subject of child prostitution is so taboo. This is unfortunate, because, the film does not seek to either condone, condemn, or exploit it. But it may be the most talked about movie of next year.

Quick Popped reviews: a quick look at current cinema: *Kentucky Fried Movie*: an extremely uneven but often hilarious string of Laugh-In gags for the big screen; *First Love*: beautiful photography com-

bines with mediocre everything else to make a theatre experience that is pleasant if little else; *Semi-Tough*: this film which is based on Dan Jenkins' novel about pro football, is not about football, but it is funny and unpredictable.

Video News: With the wave of cancellations that have hit CBS and NBC in the past few weeks, an onslaught of new series and schedule shuffling is on its way. Much of it will be tedium, but some of it shows modest promise. CBS will replace *The Betty White Show* with a new sitcom called *Another Day*. It will star Broadway-film actress Joan Hackett and *Rhoda's* ex, David Groh, and is being produced by James Komack, who is responsible for former hits *The Courtship of Eddie's Father* and *Chico and the Man*, as well as several bombs. CBS has great hopes for the show, which narrowly missed a spot on the regular fall schedule and was being warmed to replace Betty White as soon as that show's ratings

sagged, which was sooner than anyone expected. NBC, meanwhile, has announced a new slate of "Big Events". Helen Hayes, Fred Astaire, and Patty Duke Astin will star in *A Family Upside Down*, the story of two old people in love who are kept apart; the TV-movie version of the story of Leonard Matlovich's fight with the Air Force over his homosexuality has been titled *Matlovich vs the U.S. Air Force*; King will tell the story of Martin Luther King's life, and will star Paul Winfield; *Wheels*, the Arthur Hailey novel about the world of Detroit's auto business, will be brought to the small screen with a cast that will include Rock Hudson, Lee Remick, and Jessica Walter; and Bette Davis will star in a TV version of *Harvest Home*, the Thomas Tryon novel about the supernatural.

Nitery News: Bette Midler has been signed to an engagement at New York's Copacabana nightclub, the first big act

to appear there in many a moon. Many hope this will be the start of a return of big name acts to the nightclubs . . . Las Vegas has recently passed an ordinance banning gay people from many casinos, because of their supposed use as "rendevous points" by gays. Local gay activists are mounting a repeal effort . . . Lots of empty seats spotted out front at performances of Liza Minnelli's *The Act*, currently on Broadway. Mixed reviews and production problems won't keep this show from running into 1978, though; the advance has the show projected well into next summer.

Next summer will include release of two long-awaited movies; Ali McGraw, in her first film in several years, will team with Kris Kristofferson for *Convoy*, and John Travolta, Olivia Newton-John and Stockard Channing are an unlikely trio who star in the film version of the long-running off-Broadway play *Grease*. A film version of *Hair* is also in the works. It begins production as soon as that musical's stage revivals are completed, including the one set for Houston, beginning December 15th.
