While the heated competition among the three major TV networks has been going on, a strange thing has happened: Americans have stopped watching as much TV as they did a year ago. That was the surprising discovery of the A.C. Neilsen Company, the guys who obtain the ratings by surveying TV set usage. It was alarming news for the networks: they face loss of revenue if advertising rates go down as a result, but it is not surprising news to the average viewer. He realized early on in the season that, on the whole, the new shows and the returning ones as well-were boring and dull.

The networks are uncertain as to the accuracy of Neilsen's findings, but announced an impressive list of programs for the upcoming "second season" period, January through March. NBC will have several mini-series of varying lengths, including a dramatization of the life of Dr. Martin Luther King; CBS will

be celebrating its fiftieth anniversary with a week of special programming hosted by Walter Cronkite and Mary Tyler Moore; and ABC will celebrate its twenty-fifth anniversary with a four hour special as well as TV premieres of a few box office biggies.

The CBS anniversary shows should be interesting. Seven consecutive nights in February make up the anniversary celebration and will feature clips from past CBS shows, with the focus on the popular shows that were shown on that night in the past. ABC is equally promising; *The Sting*, *Lady Sings the Blues*, and *Nashville*, all for the first time, and reruns of *The Way We Were*, *Cabaret*, and *Five Easy Pieces*. ABC will also have specials featuring Cher and John Denver.

Popcorn potpourri . . . Johnny Carson is planning to host the *Tonight Show* only three times a week in the future. That's unfortunate for NBC, because the *Tonight Show* has been

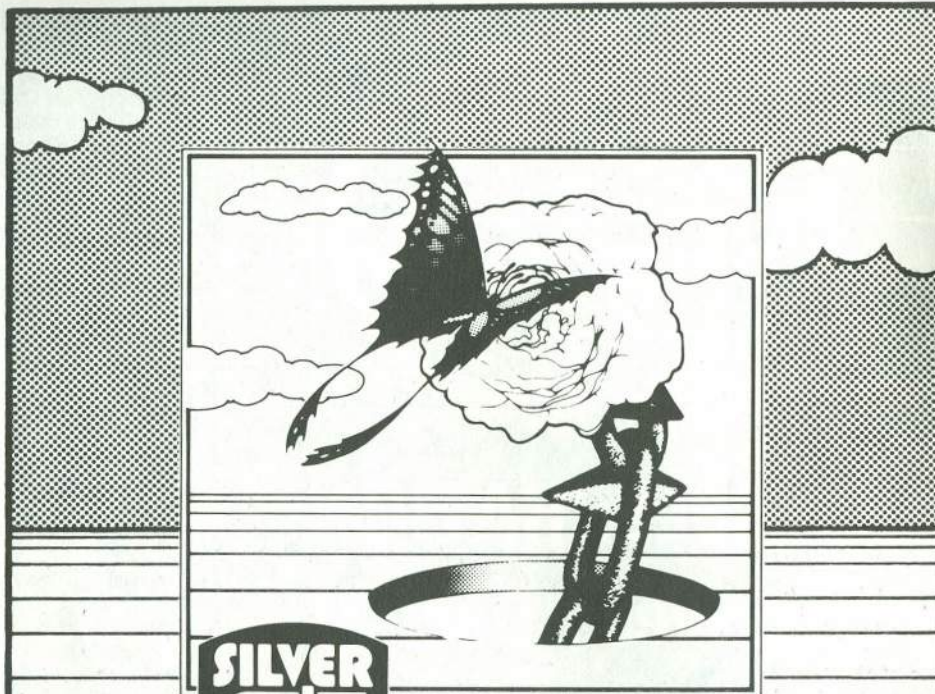

Baryshnikov has choreographed the entire program, so it should be something special . . . 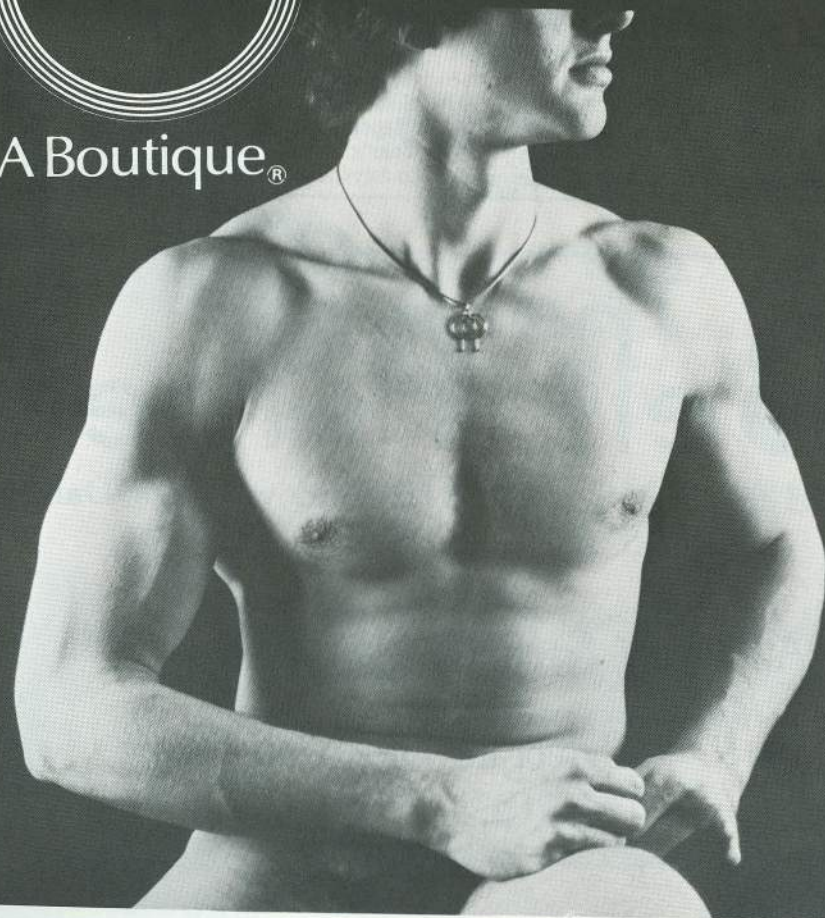


